SNACKPACKS FOR KIDS

SnackPacks for Kids provides weekly bags filled with 8 nutritious snacks to over 6,000 children identified by school personnel as being at-risk to suffer food insecurity on weekends and holidays during the school year. Volunteers are needed to:
